Historic Downtown Route – The “Mountaineer Trolley” will run continuously during the Gateway Festival. All trolley stops are marked along the route with stops at the Gazebo at Patriots Park, the Kings Mountain Historical Museum and Commons, Central United Methodist Church (until 3:00 pm) and then cruise through Central School Historic District to the Kings Mountain Art Depot and back downtown to the Gazebo. There will be stops near the Joy Performance Center from 1 pm – 1:40 pm for the free screening of “The Fall of the House of Usher” at 2:00 pm. The Trolley will run approximately every 15 minutes.

Military Park Route – There will be two trips on the “Mountaineer Trolley” for a fall foliage preview and to join Kings Mountain National Military Park in its 229th anniversary celebration of the Battle of Kings Mountain. The Trolley will be departing the Gazebo at Patriots Park (Stop #1) at 11:00 & 1:45 with a final pick up at 4:15 pm.

Parking will be available at all venues and downtown parking lots.

Information – an information booth will be located at the corner of Railroad Avenue and Gold Street.
