### **Call Meeting to Order**

Albert Petty called meeting to order.

### **Adoption of Agenda**

### **Cleveland Co Amateur Radio Service**

Rick advised the event will be held on the Camp Creek side and they monitor radio traffic around the world and document who they speak to. Trip made a motion to approve the event. Chris Gibby seconded the motion and all are in favor of holding the event.

### **Wake The World**

Rick advised that one of their comments concerning the last event was better access. It is open to the public. This is an event that allows disabled persons to water ski. Russell advised that providing access to the lake would be good enough, they should provide all other needs. Trip gave motion to approve, Chris seconded the motion and all are in favor.

### **Swimming Ordinance**

They have not allowed swimming at the lake in years, this would be a change to council to allow swimming in a certain area. Rick advised to get it in writing concerning the swimming events. Albert seemed to cover several good things, Rick suggested to take a look at it and possibly provide a map of the swimming area and add to it. Russell advised addressing the swimming events and swim areas of the lake.

### **Designated Parking for Vehicles w/ Trailers**

Last meeting it was discussed to implement signs and painting. Trip went out to the fishing tournament and took some aerial photos with the drone and he advised he would send the pictures to our group email; he also offered to take some videos of the lake. The possibility of setting up a camera to provide public access to parking at the ramp was brought up. Everyone decided that they would keep a look out for how things develop and come back to it.

### **David Caldwell- River Watcher Data Submission Updates**

Trip advised that he has not heard any further from David and he advised him that he would keep us posted about if he finds anything. Russell advised that David bought a lot of information concerning upstream issues and maybe he could provide us with continued monitoring if he does so. Rick advised we are not allowed to stock pile and there is a DEQ office in Mooresville and members could call there and provide their concerns and they may investigate it.

### **Review Engineer RFP's- Dredging**

Rick advised that management will need to review this and we will discuss it next meeting. Rick advised they were asked them to look at every grant opportunity, source of sediment and method to resolve it and short-term dredging solution.

### **Open Discussion/Commission concerns**

Russell mentioned issues with wake boats. Trip suggested creating an ordinance for the same. Russell advised maybe implementing something similar to the law that SC has concerning wake boats; because of erosion control, they could not be within a certain number of feet. Russell advised he would try to get a copy of this. Trip advised maybe a fine if violated. Russell mentioned that a homeowner brought to his attention that he had rips in his vinyl seats from

fishermen fishing. Albert was not present at the meeting but a couple members suggested getting his perspective on it. Also suggested making a note for people to be cautious when casting around boats.

**Clean Up Day and Food Truck**

Rick mentioned that the city would not mind if anyone got out and cleaned up around the shoreline. Trip advised that it would be nice to have a food truck out on the lake some Saturdays as well. Someone made mention of possibly writing something up concerning having a food truck on the lake.




