The Code Enforcement Department shall have the electricity disconnected in the case of an imminent safety hazard or illegal occupancy of the structure. Temporary power is issued for 60 days only, but may be extended in 30 days intervals if approved by the Code Enforcement Officer. It is the applicant's responsibility to apply for said extension. Without extension or Certificate of Occupancy being issued, power will be disconnected 60 days from the date of original passed inspection.

I have read and understand this document and agree with the conditions herein; if disconnection occurs due to non-compliance, I authorize the serving utility to disconnect the power and hold them harmless from any damages which may result from their actions.
